### Dr. Andrey Mazarati, MD, PhD

*Professor, Dept. of Pediatrics/Neurology Division,  
David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA, Los Angeles, CA*

Dr. Mazarati is a Professor in the Dept. of Pediatric Neurology at UCLA. He obtained his MD at Odesa Medical University, Ukraine, and his PhD at the Academy of Medical Sciences, Moscow, Russia. He started his UCLA career as a Postdoctoral Fellow under Dr. Claude Wasterlain and is currently a Professor at the Department of Pediatrics. His past research interests include the role of bioactive peptides in epilepsy, mechanisms and treatment of status epilepticus, and neurobehavioral comorbidities of epilepsy. His current research focuses on the mechanisms, biomarkers, and prevention of post-traumatic epilepsy.

Dr. Mazarati is a co-author of approximately 150 peer-reviewed papers, reviews, and book chapters and has received 13 NIH and DoD research grants, with three currently active. He has served on several ILAE and AES committees (AES/NINDS Epilepsy Research Benchmarks Committee, Translational Task Force, and Antiepileptogenesis Following TBI Task Force of ILAE). He served as an Associate Editor of *Epilepsia Open* and presently is the Associate Editor of *Epilepsy & Behavior*.
